



Le programme Suds

The Suds programme is a multi-disciplinary programme of the ENS-PSL.

Launched in June 2022 at an inaugural colloquium at the ENS, its aim is to support, coordinate and develop training and research on/with the South at the ENS, as well as to strengthen and build multidisciplinary research and training partnerships with institutions and researchers from the South.

The Suds programme is run by a collegiate board made up of representatives from the ENS-PSL scientific community and coordinated by Claire Riffard (ITEM, CNRS-ENS). In addition to ENS-PSL's scientific community, the Suds programme aims to bring together partners in the programme, including the CNRS (particularly InSHS), the ENS Foundation and a consortium of universities with which the ENS and its teaching and research staff already work.

It is supported by an international scientific advisory board.
